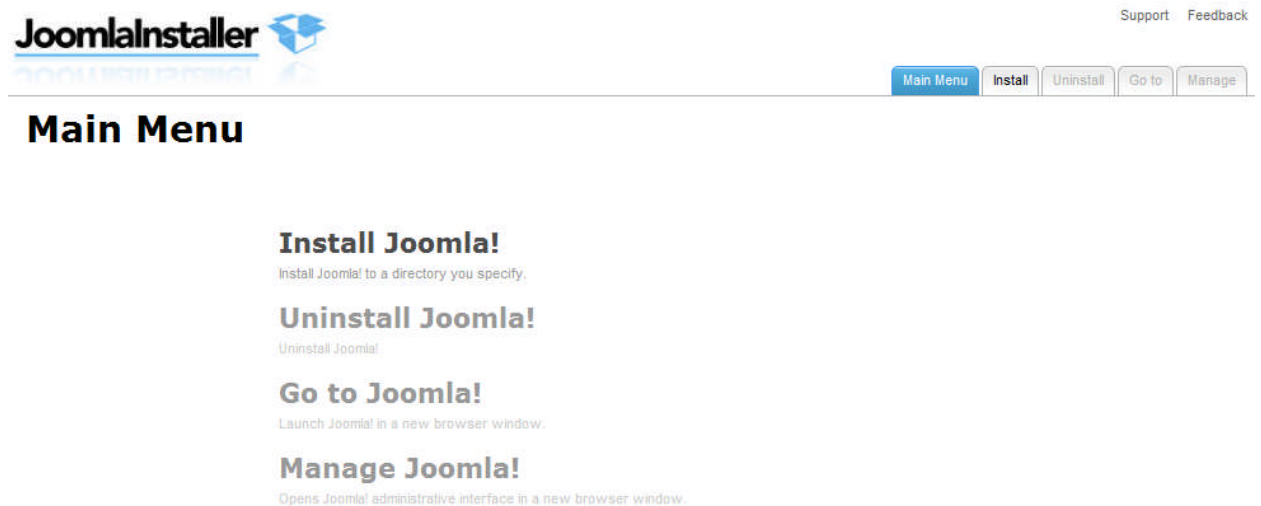
# 1 Introduction

Joomla Installer is an advanced open source Content Management System (CMS) that enables users to build websites and online applications. This application will easily install a Joomla! CMS to a directory that you specify within your web services account.

TO LAUNCH JOOMLA INSTALLER:

- Click **Joomla Installer icon**.

The application opens in a new window.



## 1.1 Navigation

The main menu is located on the top right corner of Joomla Installer:

- **Main Menu:** links you to the Main Page of Joomla Installer
- **Install Joomla!:** links you to the page where you can start installing this application
- **Uninstall Joomla!:** links you to the page where you can uninstall this application
- **Go To Joomla!:** links you to the page where you can access this application and start using it after installing it.
- **Manage Joomla!:** links you to the page where you can manage this application
- **Support:** opens online help files for Joomla Installer in a new window
- **Feedback:** allows you to send feedback concerning Joomla Installer

## 2 Joomla Installer

### 2.1 Install Joomla!

Allows you to install Joomla! on your website.

TO INSTALL JOOMLA:

1. Click **Install Joomla!**.
2. Set up administrator account.

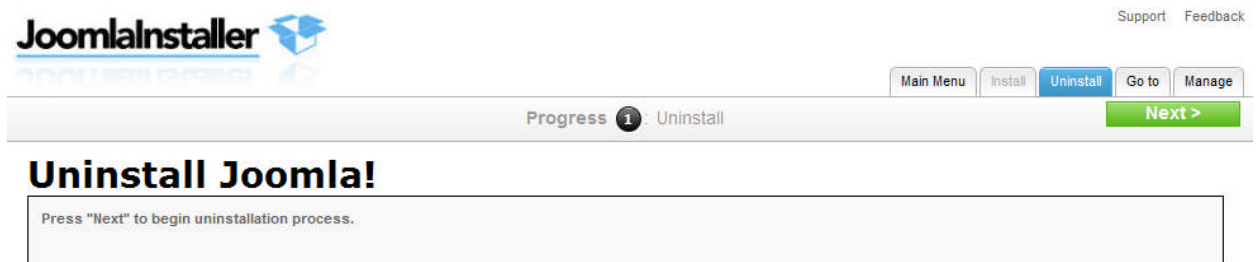

## 2.3 Go to Joomla!

Allows you to launch your Joomla! website in a new browser window.

To Go To JOOMLA!:

- Click **Go to Joomla!**.

## 2.4 Manage Joomla!

Allows you to manage the Joomla! backend. You will have to login with your administrative credentials that you created.

TO MANAGE JOOMLA!:

1. Click **Manage Joomla!**.

The backend opens in a new window.
